# 1. Information for Kiel Week 2021



Dear Sailors,

We would like to inform you about the current state of affairs for Kiel Week 2021.

Unfortunately, we have to put you off with some more details, because e.g. the state regulation of Schleswig-Holstein, which is valid for the period of the Kiel Week, will be published at the end of August.

But first we would like to remind you of a basic requirement for participation in the Kiel Week: The payment of your entry fee!

Please complete your registration in our registration portal Manage2Sail by **August**, **06**<sup>th</sup> **2021** at the latest. This includes the payment of the **current (adapted) entry fee**.

After August 6th incomplete or unpaid registrations will be deleted and sailors will move up from the waiting list to the free places. If we are not able to admit you due to the maximum number of entries after you have paid the entry fee, we will refund the entry fee.

# **Entry**

- Please inform yourself up to date about the entry and arrival regulations to and in Germany and read the hygiene regulations, which are binding for you as a participant of the Kiel Week. These will be published as part of the hygiene concept from mid-August and uploaded/sent in Manage2Sail.

Please make sure to check these regulations before your departure, as they are updated on a daily basis.









# **Accommodation**

- If you want to stay overnight at the camping site in Schilksee or if you have booked a vacation apartment or a hotel in Kiel and surroundings, the following conditions are valid at the moment:
  - o Guests may basically only be accommodated if they can show a **negative test** in written or digital form, which is presented to the accommodation establishments upon arrival. The test must have taken place max. 48 h BEFORE the start of the journey. Self-testing is not permitted.
  - o Guests must provide their **contact information**.
  - Fully vaccinated persons (at least 14 days after the last required vaccination) and recovered persons (positive PCR test result at least 28 days ago and not older than 6 months) do not have to present a negative test. Here the proof of vaccination by presentation of an international (or at least English) vaccination certificate or a vaccination certificate or the proof of convalescence is sufficient.
- The camping site in Schilksee may only be used by participants of the Kiel Week regattas and their accompanying persons.
- Since a separation of the two Kiel Week parts is planned with Wednesday (08.09) as a changeover day like last year, an arrival is only possible at the beginning of the respective part (part 1: 04.-07.09, part 2: 09.-12.09)
- These requirements are preliminary and may possibly become more stringent by Kiel Week in September.

# Check-In

Access to the event area (accreditation as a sailor or coach) you will get with your Check-In. On your way to the Check-In please stick to the distance requirements of 1.5 m. If it cannot be ensured that a 1.5m distance can be guaranteed a mask (medical or FFP2) must also be worn outside.

The check-in will take place in the boot Düsseldorf Club in Schilksee (except Aalregatta and Welcome Race – the Check-In is in Düsternbrook). In all indoor rooms on the event area **masks** (medical or FFP2) are mandatory.

You have to bring the following documents to the check-in. Without these documents it will not be possible to check in on site:

- Negative coronatest or international (or at least English) vaccination certificate or proof of convalescence (positive PCR test result, which is at least 28 days old and not older than 6 months).
- Disclaimer
- Check-In Report
- Personal Information Form (will be published with the hygiene concept from mid-August!)







## **General Information:**

- We are very happy to inform you that we will increase the **maximum number of entries** in two classes (ILCA 4 and Europe). This means that some of you can move forward in the list of participants. However, please appreciate that due to the current situation we can only accept a limited number of additional. - Please pay attention after your arrival in Kiel that there is a training ban from 02.09. 13.09.2021, see Additional Information (NoR) 1.1.1. This applies to all classes and sailors without exception! Please abide by this prohibition. It is part of the notice of race and therefore a decisive basis for the event.
- The following possibilities for a Corona quick test can be found in Schilksee and we are still trying to create two testing opportunities on the event area. Further Information will follow!
